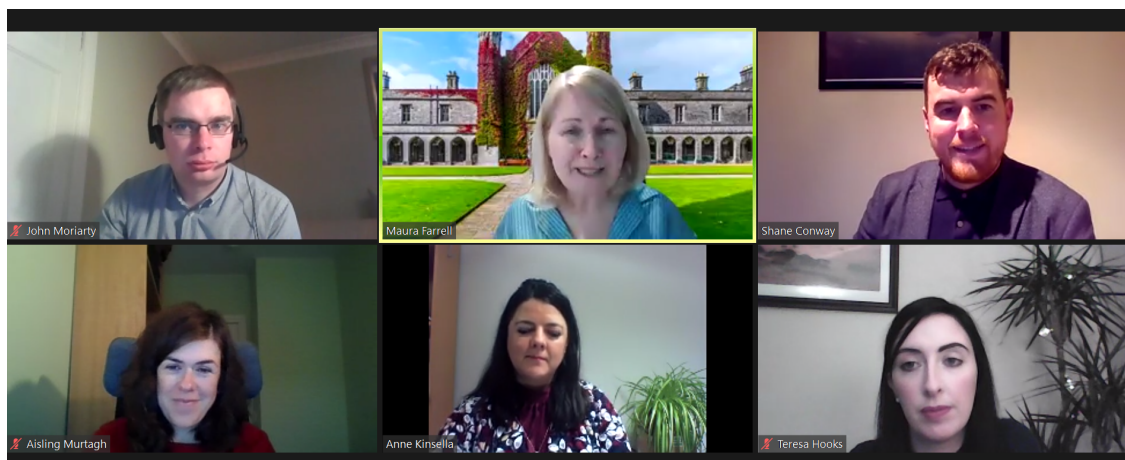

## RURALIZATION national conference in Ireland explores national and international perspectives on facilitating future farmers

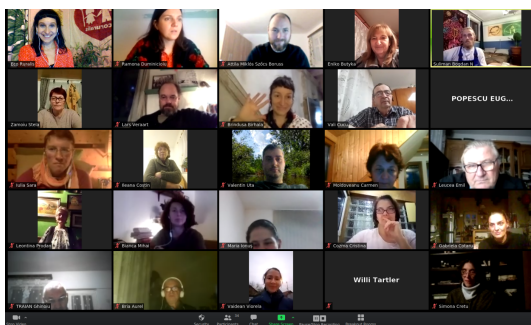

## Long-term Vision for Rural Areas



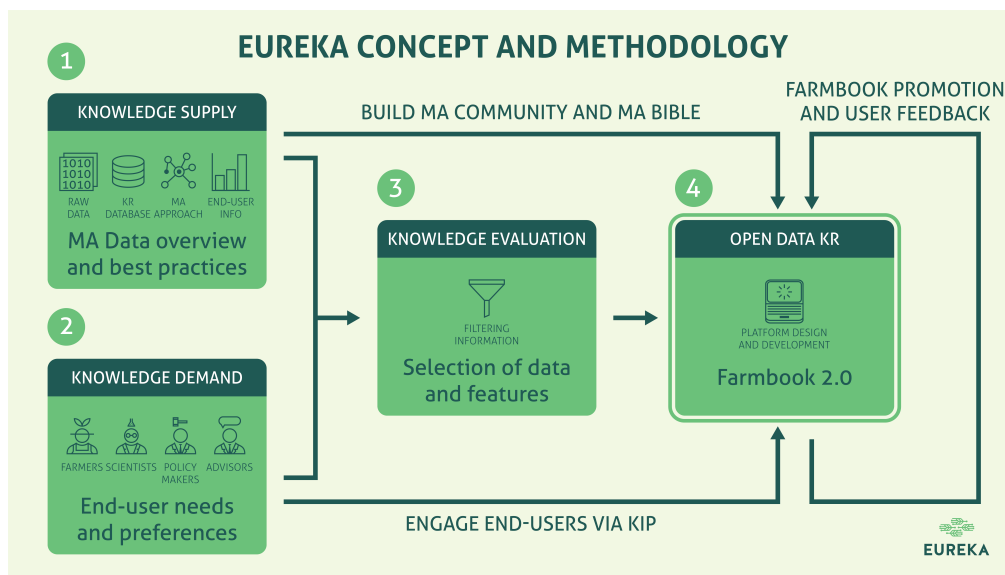

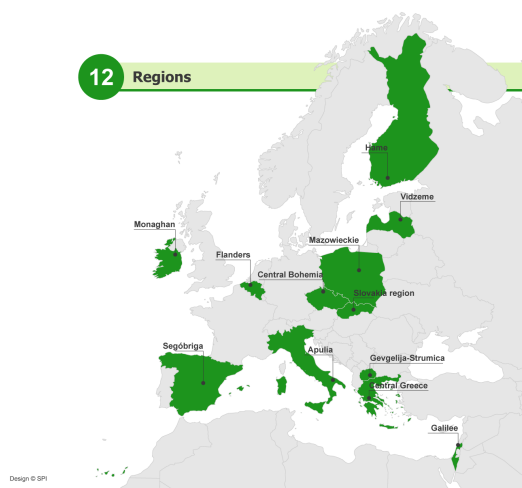
